Re-Dedication of England as the Dowry of Mary - Sunday 29

March: 'Mary's Dowry' remains a title of England, established by an act of the King in 1381, and proclaimed by Archbishop Arundel, which has never been rescinded by Monarch or Parliament. Our Bishops have, over the years, re-consecrated our country to the Mother of God for her prayers and protection, and in reparation for the sins of the past. The first time being at the request of Pope Leo XIII in 1893.

This year the Catholic people of England will once again formally dedicate both the realm and our personal lives to Mary. The rededication ceremony will happen at St Mary's Church, Derby on **Sunday 29 March**, when we will be invited to make a personal commitment by praying 'The Angelus Promise', a prayer in which we say "yes" in union with Our Lady through the words of the Annunciation.
