CAFOD Update: To keep volunteers and supporters informed about CAFOD's ongoing work, there has been a series of webinars. Two recent talks have been recorded. Crisis, conflict and climate change in Ethiopia. Conor Molloy, the country representative, who visited Tigray in February, explains how the Catholic Church is providing emergency assistance in what is a very grave situation.

The other talk is about the work of Sadaka-Reut. Established in 1983. Its grassroots dialogue and leadership development programmes seek to address the deep-seated injustices caused by the Israeli-Palestinian conflict by educating and empowering Palestinian and Jewish youth in Israel to pursue social and political change through bi-national partnership.
