St Agatha - 5 Feb (Memorial):

St Agatha (+ 251) suffered martyrdom at Catania in Sicily, probably during the time of Decius. According to a Later Life, the tortures she was subjected to included cutting off her breasts, which have become her symbol in art. She was widely venerated as a martyr and her name appears in the Roman Canon.

St Paul Miki and Companions, Martyrs - 6 Feb (Memorial):

St Paul Miki and his twenty-five companions were martyred in Nagasaki, Japan in 1597. They were crucified and then stabbed with spears, though the executioners were astounded upon seeing their joy at being thus associated with the passion of Christ. They were the first martyrs of the Far East to be canonized.

St Scholastica, Virgin - 10 Feb (Memorial):

St Scholastica (+ c.543) was the sister of St Benedict. She followed the rule of her brother near Montecassino and is regarded as the first Benedictine nun. When she met her brother for the last time, a sudden rainstorm providentially prolonged the meeting; three days later St Benedict saw her soul ascend to heaven as a dove (her symbol in art).

Our Lady of Lourdes – 11 Feb (Optional Memorial):

The feast marks the first apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary in 1858 to fourteen-year-old St Bernadette Soubirous. There were eighteen apparitions in all, the last of which was on 16 July 1858. The message of Lourdes is a call to personal conversion, prayer and charity. In a special way, the shrine has become closely associated with the sick.
