St Mathias - Feast - 14 March: St Matthias (first century) was chosen by lot to take the place of Judas among the Twelve (Acts 1: 15-26). He was present at the first Pentecost and, according to various traditions, went on to preach in Judaea, Cappadocia and Ethiopia. He was martyred possibly by means of the axe or halberd with which he is often depicted in art.
