School admissions to Catholic Secondary Academies (Year 7) - Children born between 01/09/2013 and 31/08/2014. The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is 31 October 2024. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you should also complete a supplementary information form, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You **MUST** also include the supporting evidence as required with this form, eg baptism certificate (photocopies acceptable; if you do not have the evidence contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time). Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place.

Six Welsh Martyrs & Companions (Feast) – 25 October:

The Feast commemorates six Welsh martyrs: St Richard Gwyn (c.1537-1584), St John Jones (c.1559-1598), St John Roberts (c.1575-1610), St Philip Evans (1645-1679), St John Lloyd (c.1630-1679) and St David Lewis (1616-1679). These stand as representatives of the many who suffered persecution during the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries, and risked their lives for love of the Church and the Holy Eucharist.
