St Martin I, Pope and Martyr (Opt Mem) – 13 April:

St Martin I (+655) was born in Todi (Italy) and elected Pope in 649. He called a Council to condemn the Monothelite heresy, which denied that Christ had two wills. This angered the Byzantine emperor Constans II, who sympathised with the Monothelites, and St Martin was imprisoned then banished to the Crimea where he died, broken by his sufferings. He is venerated as a martyr.
